[Xana Abreu](#) became well known to the general public in Portugal, Angola and other countries, both in music and on television, through her character Xana Toc Toc. She has received 12 platinum awards for her successful DVDs and CDs, has over 500 million views on YouTube, thousands of books sold and countless sold-out concerts.

On television, after several advertising campaigns and numerous roles in fiction such as *Tempo de Viver* (TVI), *7 Vidas* (SIC), *Jura* (SIC), *Morangos com Açúcar* (TVI) and *Casos da Vida* (TVI), she more recently joined the main cast of *Amor Amor Vol. 2* (SIC, 2021/2022) and *Sangue Oculto* (SIC, 2022/2023).

In cinema, she was part of the cast of the French film *L'homme des Foules*, directed by John Lvoff, and of *O Espelho Lento* by Solveig Nordlund, based on a short story by Richard Zimler, which won the Best Drama award at the Downtown Festival in New York.

In theatre, she performed in *O Leão Enganado* by La Fontaine, directed by Xosé Blanco Gil at Teatro Ibérico; in *João Calafate*, directed by Isabel Laginha at Teatro A Lanterna Mágica; and in the children's play *Uma Estrelinha Atrás da Porta*, in which she played "Estrelinha", also directed by Isabel Laginha at Teatro A Lanterna Mágica. She also took part in various theatre tours through schools across the country from north to south.

In voice-over and dubbing, in addition to several advertising campaigns, she voiced Koko in *Lego Ninjago – The Movie* (2017) and Queen Margarida in *O Vale Encantado* (2018).

As Xana Toc Toc, from 2011 to 2021, she recorded more than one hundred music and storytelling videos and performed numerous musical shows, consistently selling out the largest venues and festivals in the country for a decade.
